7. What is surplus value, and how is it sub-divided ?
8. What is the relationship between value and price ?
9. What determines the price of labour power ?
10. What is the function of trade unions ? Explain the socialist position on trade unionism.
11. Explain in some detail the socialist position on reforms and reformism.
12. How does crisis and recession come about in capitalism ?
13. How would socialist production avoid suffering the booms and slumps of capitalism ?
14. Explain taxation. Do workers have a stake in the state ?
15. What is the nature of the state ?
